The North Carolina End of Grade tests are designed to measure each student's proficiency on the standards for their grade level. Students will be assessed in the areas of reading and math in 3rd-7th grades and in science for 5th grader.

In the coming weeks, the teachers will prepare students for the EOG testing by some class activities, including but not limited to, sharing testing strategies, reviewing standards, and assigning some practices, etc. But your encouragement and support to your child is vital for their success too. To prepare the students for EOG assessments, please ensure your student gets a good night's sleep, has a healthy breakfast and is on time to school each day. Attendance is very important! Students should arrive on time each day so that they will not miss any instruction, and can take the assessment with their class before class starts at 8:00 a.m.

Students who are tardy will **not** be admitted to the testing session and will have to test on an alternate day.

EOG Testing Schedule

Wednesday, May 25 th , 2022	Math EOG 3 rd , 4 th , 5 th , 6 th , 7 th grades
Thursday, May 26 th , 2022	EOG Makeup
Friday, May 27 th , 2022	Science EOG 5 th grade
Monday, May 31st, 2022	EOG Makeup

Due to EOG testing, lunch schedules will be modified daily. We are asking all parents to refrain from joining us during lunch on all testing days. Thank you for your support.

Testing Tips for Parents

- Make sure your scholar gets a good night of sleep so they are alert and ready on testing days.
- Please make sure that your scholar is on time for all testing days and is in their classroom by 8:00 a.m. Scholars who arrive at school late will not be admitted into testing sessions and will have to take the assessment on an alternate day.
- Avoid scheduling any appointments that would require early dismissal on testing days.
- Ensure your scholar eats breakfast on all test days at school or at home.
- Encourage your scholar to do well and keep a positive attitude about testing.

To prepare your child for EOG in the coming weeks, please encourage your child to do the following:

- Practice math/reading on Lexia, IXI, and/or i-Ready for at least 20 minutes each day
- Complete other assignments that teachers assign and turn them in on time
- Read to your child or have your child read to you for 20 minutes each day
