The PreK program is a fee based program and is offered full day for 4 year old students. The cost is \$4250 per year and can be paid in 10 installment payments or by the semester or annually (see payment plan info below). We are pleased to be located on the campus of East Voyager Academy, NC's first Chinese Language Immersion Public Charter School. East Voyager Academy consistently scores higher than over 50% of all schools in NC for academic growth in reading and math while students are also learning to speak, read and write in Mandarin Chinese! Our PreK students also have Mandarin language and culture classes.

Our focus on math foundations while your student learns Mandarin and reading/writing in English will prepare your student to be successful in school and college. Our open house is on Monday, August 19 at 5 p.m. The first day for students is August 21. During July you will receive information about ordering school uniforms and activities planned for the 2024-25 school year.

Program Overview

Your student will begin to learn Chinese vocabulary, culture and songs while also learning to read and write in English, learning the foundations of math and science and enjoying related arts like art, music, and physical education. There are many benefits to bilingual education. Bilingual education is much more than just learning to speak a foreign language. Bilingual education includes learning about the culture and immersing students in language experience for the target language through interactive language lessons, songs, and activities. Learning the language is part of the process, but learning content while learning a target language builds cognitive processes and confidence for young learners.

Program Details and Hours of Operation

The PreK program is a separate program from East Voyager Academy, but is located in the EVA facility. The PreK program is open to students 4 years old and to students who will be 4 years old during the early part of the school year. The program follows the same calendar as East Voyager Academy. The calendar can be viewed at www.eastvoyager.org. Students must be potty trained, able to sit quietly while a short story is read, and to play well with others. Students will receive instruction in fundamentals of math, reading in English, songs and spoken vocabulary in Chinese, art, music, and exercise. Students may arrive as early as 7:15 a.m. Instruction begins at 8 a.m. The day ends at 2:45 p.m. PreK students are not eligible to stay in the East Voyager Academy after school program.
